Key Attributes

- Must be at least 25 years of age.
- Ability to demonstrate respectful and professional behavior.
- Ability to follow procedures and protocols.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, in Hindi and English.
- Ability to maintain confidential information.
- Ability to work in stressful situations.
- Freedom from conflict of interest with Athletes and/or sports within the purview of NADA.
- Awareness of, and comfort with, the responsibilities of a DCO.
- Must not have a criminal record.

Educational Qualifications

- Graduate degree in any field/discipline with a minimum of 55% from a recognized university.

Work Experience

- Possesses prior work experience or is currently working with the Central or State Governments/Any Government Undertaking/Autonomous Organization/Nursing Home in a relevant field (i.e., sport administration, pharmacy, health science, law enforcement, health science, sport science, medical science, etc.). Candidates with a minimum of three years of experience will be preferred
- Those who are above the Pay Level of 5 (as per matrix of 7th CPC) or equivalent.

- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, in Hindi and English.
- Ability to maintain confidential information.
- Ability to demonstrate respectful and professional behavior.
- Freedom from conflict of interest with Athletes and/or sports within the purview of NADA.
- Awareness of, and comfort with, the responsibilities of a BCO.
- Must not have a criminal record.

Educational Qualification

Graduate degree in a scientific discipline with a minimum of 55% from a recognized university. This may include, but not limited to, medical sciences, pharmacy, pharmacology, toxicology, life science, forensic science, nursing, midwifery, medical lab technology and phlebotomy.

Work Experience

- Possesses prior work experience or is currently working with the Central or State Governments/Any Government Undertaking/Autonomous Organization/Nursing Home in a relevant field (i.e., pharmacy, health sciences, sport science, medical sciences, etc.). Candidates with a minimum of three years of experience will be preferred.
- Those who are not below the Pay Level of 5 (as per matrix of 7th CPC) or equivalent
- Those who are qualified to collect blood samples (Phlebotomist) with experience are eligible for blood collection officer.

Key Attributes

- Age Limit: Up to 45 years
- Ability to demonstrate respectful and professional behavior.
- Ability to follow procedures, directions and instructions.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, in Hindi and English.
- Ability to maintain confidential information.
- Ability to work in stressful situations.
- Aware of, and comfortable with, the responsibilities of a Chaperone.
- Free from conflict of interest with Athletes and/or sports within the purview of NADA.
- Must not have a criminal record.

Educational Qualification

Completed higher secondary education from a recognized institution.

Work Experience

Possesses prior work experience or is currently working with the Central or State Government or any Government Undertaking/Autonomous Organization.

Work Description

- To assist Doping Control Officer and chaperoning the athletes
- Assist DCOs/BCOs in conducting education and awareness workshops/programs as and when directed by NADA.

Remunerations

- Rs 1000/- per day
 - TA/DA for sample collection for journey i.e. local/outstations shall be applicable to him/her under the applicable Government Instructions
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Additional Requirements/Conditions-

- The candidate should have the ability to work outside regular working hours (i.e., evenings, early mornings, etc.) and on weekends and holidays.
 - They should also demonstrate a willingness to travel nationwide and must abide by the rules and regulations of the parent organization when called for services to NADA as a DCO/BCO.
 - For empanelment at NADA, the candidate will be required to undergo a two-day, in-house training program for DCO/BCO.
 - Duty assignments for the DCO/BCO will be made on a 'NEED-BASIS' and only after confirming availability with the DCO/BCO.
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
