About the Institute

IIPM Bengaluru was established in November 1993 by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry (MoC&I), Government of India, as an autonomous educational institute of higher learning. During the initial years, the institute closely worked with the plantation industry and Commodity Boards of India (CBI) for the development of the Agri-plantation sector. IIPM conducted industry need-based short-duration capacity building and training programs for the stakeholders of the Agri-plantation sector that included planters, corporate managers, executive members of planter associations, small and medium entrepreneurs, officials, and scientists of the CBI, Ministries of Government of India, and officials of the State Development departments. As of March 2023, the Institute has organized 888 management development programmes benefitting 25902 stakeholders. The plantation industry has rated IIPM training programmes at 4.2 (very good category) on a five point rating scale. Overall, the Institute has organized capacity development programmes for more than 49,000 stakeholders including the student community.
