## NIELIT at a Glance

**NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (NIELIT)** is an **Autonomous Scientific Society of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India**. It was established to conduct Human Resource Development alongside other associated activities in the discipline of Information, Electronics, and Communication Technology (IECT). NIELIT plays a role with both Formal and informal learning in the domain of IECT, alongside fostering the development of industry-oriented high-quality training and education activities.

NIELIT comprises various centres in India, with its headquarters in **New Delhi**.



### Vision

To serve as the country's preeminent institution for examination and certification in the discipline of Information, Electronics, and Communications Technology (IECT) and to be a pioneer in the growth of industry-oriented professional educational and training programs.

### Objective

After developing a big number of skilled IT workers and becoming the primary source for high-quality assurance in IT training amongst the nation's non-formal institutes, NIELIT's scope is now being broadened to all parts of the nation as well as overseas.

## NIELIT Lucknow at a Glance

### Background

**NIELIT Lucknow** is a unit of **NIELIT**, an autonomous scientific society that reports to the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MoE&IT), Government of India. Over the years, the Centre has operated on a no-profit, no-loss, self-sufficient basis. In October 1996, the Centre inaugurated in Lucknow. The Lucknow centre is equipped with modern equipment and servers and covers an area of around 12000 square feet, which is completely air-conditioned. It is easily accessible from the Charbagh Railway Station, and the Inter State Bus Terminal, Charbagh. It can be conveniently accessible by Lucknow Metro from all parts of the city.

### About DGR

- Serves as an Inter Service body which reports directly to the Ministry of Defence Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare.
- On an annual basis, around 60,000 military people get retired/released at an early age so as to keep the Armed Forces' youthful profile.
- The vast majority of service people who retire are of an age when they have multiple unfulfilled domestic responsibilities, demanding the pursuit of a second employment.
- DGR aids Ex-Servicemen in training and acquiring extra skills in order to enable their resettlement through another career.

### Training directorate

- **DGR** is tasked with preparing retired military people, ex-servicemen, and widows/wards of dead troops to improve their skills and allow them to pursue second careers.
- One of the primary responsibilities of DGR is to prepare them for reintegration into civil society. Training courses are delivered at various locations around the nation by reputable government, semi-government, and commercial organizations.
- The resettlement training program includes a wide variety of topics, with a strong emphasis on the skill sets necessary in light of the changing environment. The Annual Training Programme is available for viewing on the DGR website.
